City West Housing: Safety always top concern for residents

23 November 2019 - Recently, residents and neighbours of our O'Dea Avenue building in Zetland received notification of a CWH Development Application for the replacement of some external cladding.

As part of a review of the external cladding on all of our buildings CWH identified the external cladding over the retail space of this building could be considered combustible.

We anticipate that approval from the City of Sydney will be received before the end of the year which will allow work on the replacement of the cladding to start early in 2020.

No additional safety requirements have been placed on CWH by City of Sydney in relation to this building. The issue has been assessed as posing a low level of risk. There are no issues with the cladding on the remaining portfolio.
